Mental Health Support



Where children have received ELSA in school and are requiring additional support, the school can access further help via Mindworks Mental Health Support Team. The Mental Health Support Team in Surrey is a school-based service, which supports the mental health of children and young people in schools across Surrey.

Support and advice is offered to key people (teacher and or parent/ carer) around the child or young person to enable them to identify any concerns, understand what has happened for that child or young person and support any developing mental health needs.

This involves the mental health team visiting schools at intervals during the year, to provide in person consultation sessions with staff to discuss children and young people.
