

We set up the experiment making sure that we used the same amount of water each time, and also used a stopwatch to time how long the water took to travel down the pipe. We had lots of fun being scientists!

In keeping with our termly topic 'Into the woods' this week in Hedgehog class we used natural materials to make crowns. In P.E we have been creating our own dance using actions and pathways whilst keeping in time to the beat of the music.

We have really enjoyed finding treasure in forest school and working collaboratively and matching animals to their habitats in science lessons this week.




Value of the Month Month This week the children have been 'Making a Noise About Bullying'. In assembly the children have been learning about teasing and how,

We also learnt that Diwali is known as the 'festival of lights' and is celebrated in lots of different ways; they visit the Temple, have fireworks, do rangoli, clean and tidy and have a family feast.
