

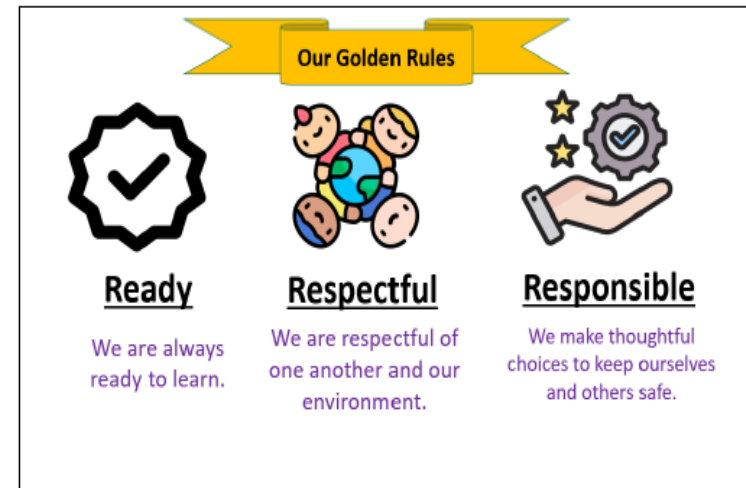

## Anti-Bullying Leaflet

These are our golden rules:



Consequences of unacceptable behaviour:

**Step One:** A verbal warning is given and a reminder of the golden rules and expectations.

**Step Two:** A second warning is given about which golden rule/s have been broken.

**Step Three:** Reflection time in the classroom/playground or with the deputy head. Teacher informs child's adult about their behaviour.

**Step Four:** Restorative conversation.

## What is Bullying?

A bully is someone who purposefully tries to hurt someone, or their feelings over and over again in **person and online.**

## What do you do if you think you are being bullied?

- Tell the bully to stop. Remember our school phrase: 'Stop it, I don't like it!'
- Tell an adult you trust at school (or write it down)
- Tell an adult at home
