End of Year Milestones



What must the children achieve in Art in order to be ready for next year? (6-10)

Year One:

- Use scissors effectively
- Confidently mix primary colours to make secondary colours
- Successfully make simple joins by manipulating modelling material or pasting carefully
- To be able to produce a clean image when printing
- Observe anatomy- encourage accurate drawings of people.
- Ensure they know the names of all colours
- Use appropriate language to describe tools, process etc.

Year Two:

- Know how to make colours darker without the use of black
- Know how to make many tones of one colour using white
- Sketch to make quick records of something
- Talk simply about own work and that of other artists
- Construct from found junk materials – effectively!
- Mix colour to match those of the natural world, colours that might have a less defined name
