



Wallace Fields Infant School & Nursery End of Year Milestones



What must the children achieve in Reading in order to be ready for next year? (6-10)

Year One:

- To recognise and read most Year 1 CEWs by sight.
- To check that a text makes sense and to self-correct as they read.
- To discuss a wide range of texts beyond those they can read independently.
- To discuss the significant events in a text.
- To discuss word meanings.
- To make simple inferences.
- To make predictions based on what has been read so far.
- To use their sounds to decode unfamiliar words.
- To recognise all 40+ phonemes which have been learnt.

Year Two:

- To recognise and read most Year 2 CEWs by sight.
- To read words accurately without over sounding and blending, demonstrating fluency.
- To sound out unfamiliar words accurately.
- To correct any inaccurate reading.
- To participate in discussions around books and explain their understanding and express their views.
- To discuss the sequence of events in books.
- To ask and answer questions about a text.
- To discuss and clarify the meanings of words.
- To make inferences on the basis of what is being said and done.
